<b>Additions to the Agenda</b>	None
<b>Approval of the Agenda</b>	Motion to approve by Laura Shakarjian, supported by Jane Lindhout. None opposed. Agenda approved
<b>Approval December Minutes</b>	Motion to approve by Lori Walbeck, supported by Deb Price. None opposed. Minutes approved.
<b>Approval Treasurer's Report</b>	The concessions income will be used to pay off the tour and band camp balance. Motion to approve by Sue Pethoud, supported by Laura Shakarjian. None opposed. Treasurer's report approved.
<b>President's Report</b>	<b>April Wyncott</b> waived her report and introduced two senior Wind Ensemble students; <b>Yewon Youm</b> and <b>Laura VerHulst</b> who presented a proposal for a Booster sponsored dance in the band room after Band Festival on 2/13/10. Boosters voted to support this event with chaperones. Mr. Pethoud and the students will contact Mr. Hamman, will be contacted first for permission.
<b>Director's Report</b>	<b>Mr. Pethoud</b> reported that the Livingston County Honors Band Concert on Feb. 1 was successful. Solo and Ensemble Festival on Feb. 6 at Hartland High School had 103 events performed and 53 earned "1" ratings by Brighton students. Concert Band and Symphony Band will be playing in a pre-festival concert on March 4.
<b>Committee Reports</b>	<b>Discussion</b>
<b>Spring Fund Raiser</b>	<b>Peggy Weingartz</b> announced that the fund raiser will start after band festival in March and end before Spring Break. Profits will be used by students for band camp expenses.
<b>Little Caesars' Pizza Night</b>	<b>Laura Shakarjian</b> said that Little Caesars' will provide one check at the year's end for the pizza nights. Future Pizza Nights are: 2/24/10; 3/22/10; 4/28/10; 5/17/10; and 6/1/10
<b>Band Aide</b>	<b>Sue Pethoud</b> announced the band camp dates: 8/22/10 – 8/28/10. Cost will probably be around \$15 more than last year. Students can check their band points are up-to-date.
<b>Concerts</b>	<b>Jane Lindhout</b> reminded us of the date changes for the May concerts: Tuesday, 5/25/10 for Concert Band, Symphony Band, Wind Symphony and 5/27/10 for the 75 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration, the Wind Ensemble and the Alumni Band Concert.
<b>Concessions/Football</b>	<b>Laura Shakarjian</b> has two possible volunteers to take over football concessions: Lori Allen and Leanne Saxman ☺. April also requested a "Traffic Control in the Stands" position for next year. This will include multiple parents who can watch the raincoats in the stands and clear a path for the band students when they return from the field.
<b>Concessions/Basketball</b>	<b>Debbie Noetzel</b> suggested a "Beverage Coordinator" position for all the concessions and volunteered to fill this position in the fall ☺. A Basketball Concession parent will be needed for next school year.
