

Hello Parents,

We hope you are doing well and your students are excited about band camp. We have a few things we would like to reiterate ahead of band camp check-in tomorrow morning.

Check-in

- Arrive at BHS at 8:15 AM to drop off medication with the nurses OR at 8:30 if students do not have medication.
- Please do not be late, the buses will depart at 9:00 AM.
- Medications for students must be in their original containers in a clear ziplock bag with the student's name on it. Please only send enough for the week.
- Students will check in with their cabin parents before loading the buses. Not sure who that is? Here is the [cabin list](#).
- All students, regardless of vaccination status, must show their negative COVID test result (Take a RAPID test at home tonight or tomorrow morning and bring it to check-in).
 - If your student has a positive COVID test, please keep them at home and notify Gabrielle Hoffman and Laura Burnham immediately (hoffmag@brightonk12.com, bandcamp@brightonbandboosters.org)

BEFORE YOUR STUDENT LEAVES HOME Check to make sure your student has everything they need, including:

- Bagged lunch and drink for the ride up
- Instrument, music, and folio/lyre unless it was loaded on the trailer on Friday
- Uniform: Orange polo, black shorts, black shoes, black socks (If ordered this week, it will arrive at camp)
- Clothes for both warm and cool temperatures
- Bedding
- Toiletries
- Two pairs of tennis shoes for marching.
 - Sandals are OK for wearing around camp but not on the field. They must be closed-toe and have a backstrap.
 - No flip-flops are allowed except in the cabin.

Pick-Up

- Please arrive at YMCA Camp Nissokone on Saturday, August 27, between 12:00 and 12:30. The show begins at 1:00, and you will want to bring lawn chairs.
- Parents are not permitted to drive their vehicles beyond the camp office. There is plenty of parking in the parking area across from the field and along the camp road.
- Students may not leave camp until parents check out students with the cabin chaperone after the show.

- Students may not ride home with another parent unless we have a [signed form](#) (page 18) on file with Laura Burnham (bandcamp@brightonbandboosters.org).
