

# Brighton Band Boosters

As the parent or guardian of a Brighton Band student you are automatically a member of the Brighton Band Boosters. The Boosters organization exists to support and promote the directors and students of the Brighton Bands at all levels; Intermediate, Middle, and High school. There are many tasks to accomplish each year, from fund raising, soliciting sponsors, and planning social events, to driving students on Tag Days, fitting uniforms, distributing half-time snacks at home football games, and *so much more*. Participation by all parents/guardians at all levels is crucial to the success of our organization. At the high school level, parent volunteerism is required in order for your student(s) to qualify for any Boosters financial support that may be offered in years when the band goes on tour. **The minimum volunteer commitment for high school parents/guardians is two volunteer shifts per student, per year (concessions is STRONGLY encouraged)** that your children are in one of the high school bands, although more is always welcome and appreciated!

The subsidy incentive policy, based on parent volunteers, is defined in the following manner:

- 2-4 Shifts, \$100 per student in the family
- 5-11 Shifts, \$150 per student in the family
- 12-19 Shifts, \$200 per student in the family
- 20+ Shifts, \$400 per student in the family

Parents DO NOT earn points on a student's behalf.

The Brighton Band Boosters holds monthly meetings during the school year on the first Monday of each month (provided school is in session that day) at 7:00pm in the High School Band Room. Please consider becoming an actively involved member by attending the Boosters meetings.
